What Are Outpatient Rehab Centers?

Outpatient therapy is often less expensive than inpatient treatment but can be as effective. Not all outpatient rehab centers have the same offerings, so it is vital to determine what is included. Additionally, outpatient drug rehab programs can be longer than inpatient drug rehab, giving you support for an extended period of your early sobriety.

How Do They Differ From Inpatient Rehab?

The super-easy answer is that inpatient rehab requires you to stay overnight at the rehab facility while the outpatient does not. However, this answer oversimplifies the differences and fails to acknowledge the similarities. The most significant difference between the two is that you can attend treatment at an outpatient drug rehab center while continuing to fulfill your outside responsibilities for your employment or your family. The added benefit is that you would satisfy those responsibilities with an additional support system to help you navigate life in sobriety. Inpatient treatment requires that you remove yourself from your life and focus solely on your recovery. Your own personal circumstances will help you determine the most appropriate treatment for you.

Who Should Go to an Outpatient Drug Rehab Center?

Research has demonstrated that outpatient drug rehab centers can be as effective as inpatient drug rehab centers. Outpatient drug rehab can be a part of a treatment plan that might begin with detox and/or inpatient treatment. Alternatively, outpatient drug rehab can be attended in place of inpatient rehab. 


