Such a hospitalization program ensures that a patient also receives all intensive treatment needed, even though they are not staying overnight. Many such hospitalization programs provide different kinds of addiction therapy options, a bit similar to those given in an in-patient setting. Some of them include dialectical behavior therapy and cognitive-behavioral therapy. Both treatments are designed to help a patient deal with the negative thought patterns that lead to addiction. They also help to regulate new emotions and develop new strategies to cope.

Intensive outpatient program for Missouri residents

An **intensive outpatient** program follows after completing your partial hospitalization program. Here, you are given more freedom to get back to your regular daily routine while making the necessary progress through your addiction treatment. However, depending on your addiction case, you may need to complete an in-patient addiction program before getting the chance to step down to an intensive outpatient treatment program. But depending on what your individual needs are, it may be appropriate to start at this treatment level.

Flexible outpatient program for Missouri residents

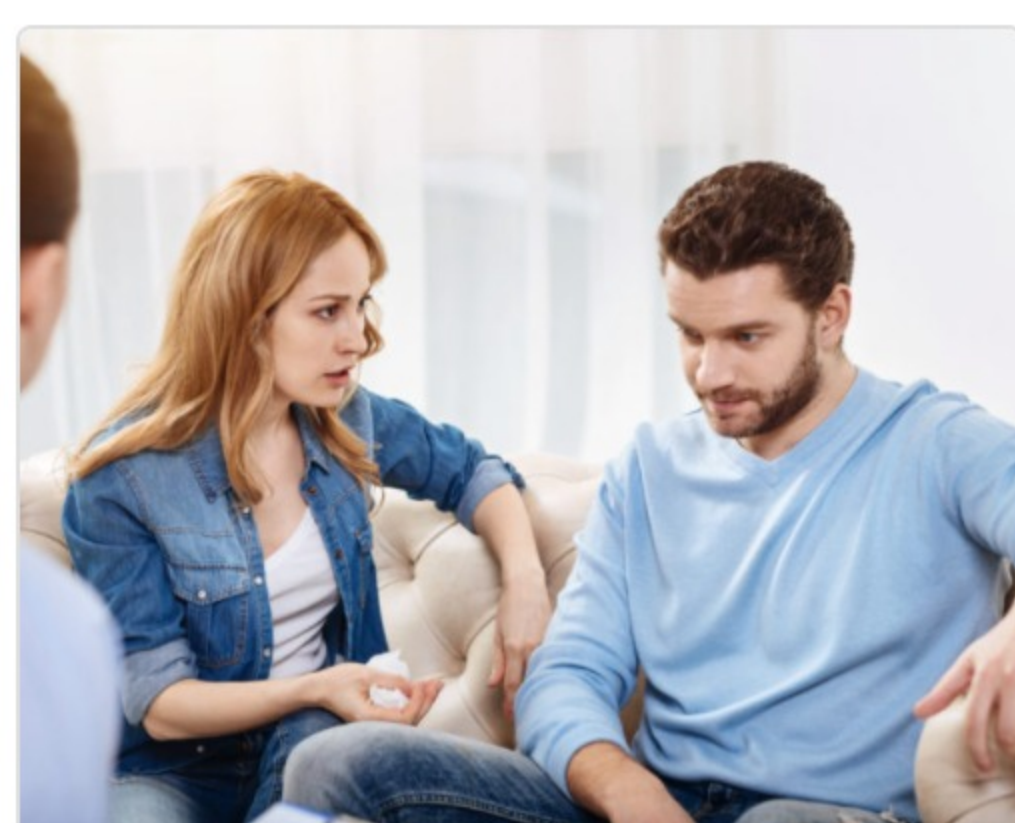
